Course Description

In this comprehensive two-day course attendees will build the skills needed to become a high-performing team member of an Agile Release Train (ART) and learn how to collaborate effectively with other teams by becoming a SAFe® 5 Practitioner (SP). Attendees will gain an in-depth understanding of the ART, how it delivers value, and what they can do to effectively perform their role using Scrum, Kanban, and XP.

Attendees will also learn how to write stories and break down features, plan and execute iterations, and plan Program Increments. Finally, they'll learn about the continuous delivery pipeline and DevOps culture, how to effectively integrate with other teams in the program, and what it takes to continuously improve the train. At the end of the course, the attendees will be eligible to take the SAFe® Practitioner (SP) exam and a one-year certified membership as a SAFe® Practitioner upon passing the exam.

Individuals who will benefit from this course include Program or Project Manager, Scrum Master, Team Lead, Release Train Engineer, Business Analyst, Agile Coach, Consultant, Architect, Engineer, Developer, Director, Product Manager, Product Owner, Program Manager, Change Agent, Operations Programmer and those interested in pursuing a SAFe® Practitioner (SP) certification.
