Course Description

In this comprehensive two-day course, attendees will build the skills needed to become a high-performing team member of an Agile Release Train (ART) and learn how to collaborate effectively with other teams. Attendees will gain an in-depth understanding of the ART, how it delivers value, and what they can do to effectively perform their role using Scrum and Kanban.

Attendees will also learn how to break down features into stories, plan/execute iterations and Planning Intervals (PIs). Finally, they'll learn about the continuous delivery pipeline and DevOps culture, how to effectively integrate with other teams in the release train, and what it takes to continuously improve the train.
